

The Morning Star Children's Home houses forty-two orphans and has been at the heart of the organization since our inception. We provide uniforms, shoes, and sports clothing, and the children are also encouraged creatively through sponsored art therapy classes and a music program. As a step towards self-reliance, we built a chicken coop, provided poultry, and delivered a double-sized freezer as a sustainable source of revenue for the home.

Education and literacy drives many of our projects. Due to the scarcity of learning materials available in rural communities, we distribute textbooks and school supplies where possible. Sixty-three children were helped for this project. 


SEEDS FOR GROWTH KITALE, KENYA
