

FISH FARM SIKIZANA TRUST RESCUE CENTER, MTITO ANDEI, KENYA

Feeding the future.

The Sikizana Trust in Kenya provides much needed resources for abandoned children and those who are victims of abuse, whether it's physical abuse, neglect, early marriage or child labor. The Trust has established a rescue center to offer children in need temporary shelter, back-to-school programs, litigation services and medical care.

NOTE OF THE PROJECT O

SEVEN SCHOOLS IN KIAMBU COUNTY, KENYA

Bringing harmony to schools.

Most public schools in this area cannot afford instruments and instructors to teach music to their students. By providing instruments, instructors, and a safe academic environment, TGE, along with the Ministry of Education of Kenya and the Constituency Development Fund of Kiambu County, are giving children in the community the gift of music and an opportunity to develop new skills and discover talents they never knew they possessed.





A music program will enrich the learning experience for students and increase their interest in attending school. Thanks to our generous donors, we've provided thousands of instruments to the school children, including recorders, pianos, drums, trumpets and trombones. The Kiambu Music Program will first be introduced to seven public primary schools with approximately 600 students per school. Eventually, this program will benefit more than 4,000 Kenyan students each year. Thank you for sharing the gift of music!



NEW CLASSROOMS

MAASAI VILLAGE, KENYA

Dreaming a brighter future.

We were thrilled to be able to build a two-classroom school in a remote village of Maasai, that gives children, and more specifically girls in the region, access to education. The only other school in the area is located miles away, and the families of this Maasai village did not want their young children to make the dangerous walk to a school so far away. Constructing a new school in the village was crucial to ensuring a better future for the Maasai children. Our volunteers participated in the opening ceremony of the school in August 2019.











The village chief spoke at the event, emphasizing his commitment to end marriage slavery in Maasai land. He reminded the entire village that they no longer practice this custom, and that they want to do everything they can to provide education for these young girls who dream of a brighter and independent future.

SOCCER OUTREACH FANTASY SOCCER ACADEMY, KITENGELA, KENYA

Scoring future goals.

Most children in Kajiado County come from underprivileged backgrounds around the struggling community of Kitengela. Unfortunately, if they are not engaged early enough, many of these kids fall into drug abuse, prostitution, illegal gangs and even terrorism. The Fantasy Soccer Academy offers an amazing opportunity to engage these children and keep their future dreams alive. With a soccer for education approach, this program teaches valuable life skills to help children overcome challenges like unemployment and economic hardship. TGE supports the Academy by funding a sustainable custom-branded jersey project, which gets the kids involved in designing, cutting, printing and selling their jerseys. Extending hearts and hands.

I came here with my family and I feel like it has been a life-changing experience for all of us. I really loved being here and gaining a global perspective. I would do it again in a heartbeat!




